Using the Summon Central Index Content in Primo Central

- Ingest records harvested and enriched by Summon for its Central Index

- More data sources
- Metadata Librarian team
- Enriched data
 - Ulrich's
 - Peer reviewed indicator
 - Serial type
 - Disciplines
- Granular resource types (e.g. journal article vs. trade publication article).

- Serial type
 - “Mixed Results List”
 - Boost scholarly material
- Master Journal Title List



Using Controlled Vocabulary

- Use controlled vocabularies from ProQuest A/I databases
 - Help us to identify topic searches
 - Improve and standardize topics in records
 - Topic exploration





Implementing Summon functionality in Primo

Database/Resource Recommender

- Query matched against a pre-defined list of tags and displays associated databases

8,401,511 results sorted by [relevance](#) 

Add results beyond your library's collection



Database Recommendations

Web of Science - Web of Science (a.k.a. Web of Knowledge): Provides citations covering over 10,000 high-impact journals in the sciences, social sciences, and arts and humanities, as well as international proceedings coverage for over 120,000 conferences.


ERIC (ProQuest) - The ERIC (Education Resources Information Center) database is sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education to provide extensive access to education literature to augment American education by increasing and facilitating the use of educational research and information to improve practice in learning, teaching, educational decision-making, and research.

Topic Exploration

- Query is matched with list of topics
- Topic pane
 - Entry from a Reference work (Encyclopedia Britannica, Credo Reference, Gale Reference, Wikipedia)
 - Link to related local LibGuides

“Best Bet”

- Similar to Database recommender but can display anything in a static HTML
- List of pre-defined tags is matched with user’s query
 - E.g. “Library hours” → Library opening hours

Journal Pane (Summon and Primo road-map)

- If query is for a specific journal → display a “Journal Pane”:
 - Information about the journal
 - Library holdings
 - Links to current issues

Better Integration with RefWorks & Syndetics

- Add to RefWorks → “Search Primo”
- Use RefWorks as central eShelf
- Use Syndetics API to display Syndetics content as a native Primo page
